Next CSC Meeting is June 27 – 29 in Visalia – Steve is not able to attend and looking for another delegate that wishes to attend. Chapter is reimbursed by CSC \$500 for a chapter that attends and is a great opportunity to meet other Vietnam veterans.

Lawsuit filed approximately 2 years ago to force the West LA VA to use the land that was allocated for veteran use and not to be used for commercial or other purposes. VVA National, Local VVA chapters and some of the American Legion Posts in the area have signed onto the lawsuit in support. Lawsuits have allowed some of the land to be used for Veteran housing, but still a very long way to go.

Reminder that all veterans have burial and other benefits, and it is critical that the veteran has their DD214 available to the Family and information on what needs to be done for a proper burial. If not sure what needs to be done, please reach out to the local VSO or the Vet Center to make sure this information is available. California AVVA is willing to assist as needed.
